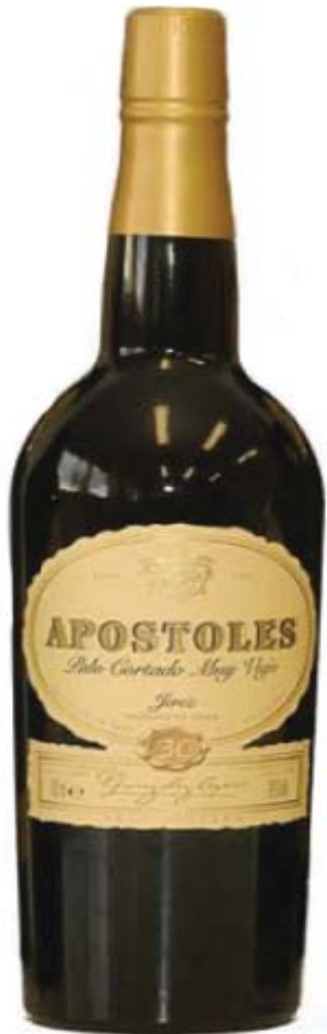




## Enjoy Gonzalez Byass Apostoles, Palo Cortado Muy Viejo for Christmas
